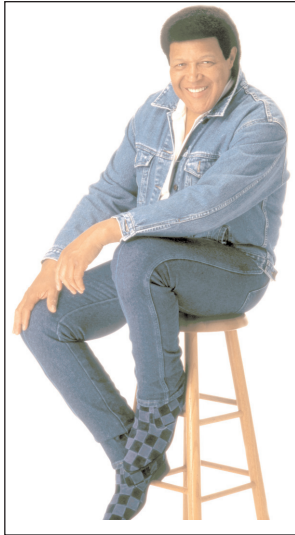


Valenti International to host fundraising event with Chubby Checker

Chubby Checker revolutionized popular culture and changed the music industry when he appeared on American Bandstand in 1960 and performed "The Twist," launching a new era in rock and roll.
